GBT was established in 1953 as a cooperative to provide quality telecommunications in rural Kansas, eventually building 18 telephone exchanges to serve our Member-Owners (Customers). Capital credits are allocated each year based on each traditional telephone customer's usage, and when the cooperative has a profitable year after all expenses and future infrastructure needs are addressed, a percentage of the capital credits are paid back to the memberowners with Board approval.

For the 36th year, the Board of Directors has voted to retire and pay out capital credits back to the members. GBT Controller Drew Clarke says, "The overall health and prosperity of GBT shines through with this retirement as the difficulties of 2022 weighed down on businesses across the globe. The staff at GBT remains focused on providing top quality services to our members in an efficient manner so that we can continue retiring capital credits to our members for years to come!"

# PROTECT YOUR TECH FROM FROSTY DAMAGE

In chilly weather, electronic devices feel the frosty sting too. Freezing temperatures can damage device batteries, reducing their future charge capacity.

Sudden temperature shifts, like going from cold outside to warm indoors, may cause condensation inside devices, leading to short circuits that can fry parts. Screens, especially on larger devices like tablets or laptops, are at risk of cracking in freezing temperatures, allowing moisture in and potentially causing short circuits. To keep your tech toasty, keep them indoors within their comfy temperature range of 32 to 100 degrees Fahrenheit, and steer clear of leaving them in frigid spots like cars.

### **Christmas Chex Mix**

Prep time: 15min | Cook time: 1 hr 10 min | Servings: 16

This is an excellent treat that is great to have on hand around the holidays!

### Ingredients

- -1 (12 ounce) package crispy corn -2 cups brown sugar and rice cereal (such as Crispix®)
- -3 cups pecan halves
- -3 cups whole almonds
- -1 cup corn syrup
- 1/2 cup butter

11/2 teaspoons vanilla extract

### **Directions**

1. Preheat oven to 250 degrees F (120 degrees C). Lightly butter a large roasting pan. 2. Mix corn and rice cereal, pecans, and almonds together in the prepared roasting pan. 3. Combine brown sugar, corn syrup, and butter in a saucepan; bring to a boil. Heat to 240 degrees F (115 degrees C) or until a small amount of syrup dropped into cold water forms a soft ball that flattens when removed from the water and placed on a flat surface. Remove saucepan from heat and stir vanilla extract into syrup. 4. Drizzle syrup over cereal mixture and toss to coat. 5. Bake cereal mixture in the preheated oven for 30 minutes: stir and continue baking for 30 minutes more. Spread cereal mixture in 1 layer onto 2 lightly buttered baking sheets, separating any large chunks with 2 forks; allow to cool.
